

ASNTR 2023 Travel Award Application Guidelines

ELIGIBILITY:

Graduate students, medical students and postdoctoral fellows conducting research in neural therapy and repair are eligible to apply. **Applicants with appointments above postdoctoral fellow are ineligible to apply for this travel award.** All applicants must be the presenting author of an abstract submitted online to the ASNTR no later than January 20, 2023. **Submission of abstracts to the ASNTR website for the 2023 meeting is a separate, additional process from this travel award application and must be completed prior to submitting your Travel Award Application.** Specific submission instructions for the travel award are detailed below.

- **Conference registration fees are not covered by this travel award.**
- **No more than five total awards per individual, regardless of change in academic degree (Masters or PhD), will be allowed.**

SUBMISSION REQUIREMENTS:

In addition to the online abstract submission process, please email a single pdf file to Donna Morrison, the ASNTR Director (asntr.office@gmail.com) **no later than 11:59pm (EST) on January 20, 2023.** The single pdf file must be formatted in the following way:

Page 1: Cover Sheet - The cover sheet should contain the following information as illustrated by the following example:

Page 2: Abstract - Each abstract should be submitted in Times New Roman, 12 point font.

The title should be brief and specific. The title should contain, in the following order: title, name(s) and affiliation(s) of author(s) including city, state, postal code, and country. The presenting author's name should be underlined. The text is to be prepared as a single paragraph and double-spaced. Abbreviations must be defined when first used. Upload the abstract as a word document only!

When submitting your abstract online, please make sure you indicate whether a poster or oral presentation is preferred, and indicate the most suitable category for your abstract. Also place a check in the box if you are interested in preparing a manuscript for consideration in a special issue of one of our affiliate journals.

The text of your abstract should not exceed 300 words.

Prepare abstracts carefully; they will be printed exactly as they appear. If your abstract is not in the proper format it will be returned to you for corrections.

Page 3: A “Statement of Need” cover letter - State why you desire to attend the ASNTR conference and what additional resources, if any, are available to you to cover travel to the ASNTR conference. This letter should be signed by you and countersigned by your advisor, scanned and incorporated into the pdf file.

Page 4 and beyond: Your updated curriculum vitae (CV), please limit this to three pages.

Please save all pages as a single pdf file, use your last name and “TA” in the title of the file. Example: “Neuroscience TA.pdf”

TRAVEL AWARD SELECTION PROCESS:

Graduate Students/Medical Students and Postdoctoral Fellows will be judged separately. Abstracts will be judged by the ASNTR Education and Training Committee using four different criteria:

- 1) the quality of the scientific writing,
- 2) the potential impact of the findings on the scientific field,
- 3) the degree of innovation in the research approach and
- 4) the amount/types of outcome measures utilized and completed.

Notification of awardees will take place no later than March 17, 2023. As a condition of this award, we request that you attend the 2023 ASNTR Workshop, to be held at the Sheraton Sand Key Resort (ASNTR conference site) from 1:00 – 4:00 pm on Thursday, April 27th. Travel arrangement should be made to accommodate this timeframe. Awards will be presented to awardees in the form of a check in a special session at the ASNTR conference.

RULES OF ACCEPTANCE OF TRAVEL AWARDS:

All applicants receiving a travel award must present their research either as an oral presentation or during the poster session as determined by the ASNTR Program Committee. Applicants submitting the highest rated abstracts may be asked to give an oral presentation at the meeting. If you are unable to give an oral presentation you must present your research as a poster, no one but you may present your awarded abstract.
